BIOGRAPHY

Since their explosive debut on the music scene in 2008 at the international Emergenza competition, Third Place quickly established themselves in the pop-rock world. Their first anniversary was celebrated with flair, earning a remarkable 8th place out of 250 artists at the legendary Medley in Montreal. Since then, their rise has only accelerated, confirmed by their 6th place finish the following year. These moments revealed Third Place's true calling: to electrify crowds during live performances.

With a sound that is both commercial and unique, Third Place has always captivated their audience. Their self-produced debut album, "Keep Your Dream Alive" (2008), marked the beginning of an expanding fan base, further amplified by their first single, "Look At Me Now," which climbed to 66th place on the Top 100 Anglophone Correspondant chart in 2009. Their presence on MusiquePlus and MuchLoud, through the music videos for "Look At Me Now," "Feel The Beat," and "Don't Stop," solidified their status as rising stars.

Their second album, "Lifeland" (2010), physically sold over 4,000 copies, showcasing Third Place's artistic evolution and their talent for electrifying performances. Their success in competitions like Cliftonband and Musiquaité allowed them to play in major shows such as the Vans Warped Tour and share the stage with icons like All Time Low, Shinedown, and Puddle of Mudd.

A major turning point came in 2011 with the signing of a licensing contract with "Let Artists Be (L-Abe)" and national distribution via "Select Distribution," leading to a re-release of "Lifeland" with new tracks, including a cover of The Supremes' "You Can't Hurry Love" and an original French song.

Third Place has performed over 400 concerts, following a tour in Ontario and Quebec in 2013-2014. Their desire to evolve artistically is evident with a single listen to their 2015 EP, "Rise of Chaos," produced in collaboration with Luc Tellier.

The band's North American tour from 2016 to 2018, spanning from Quebec to California, was a mission to share their new material. Third Place then won the "Rockalypse" music competition in 2019, which secured them their first tour in Italy, including a performance at the Subiaco Rock & Blues Festival.

For their upcoming album, Third Place will work on their theatrical rock sound, combining influences from various musical styles to present grand arrangements and poignant, unsettling lyrics amplified by powerful vocal harmonies.

The band's journey is a testament to their unwavering passion for music and their determination to leave an enduring mark on the pop-rock scene!
